### LEAD Program Learning Community Sessions

All Learning Community sessions are facilitated by Cohort Mentors who are Intern Principals. Attendance for all Learning Community sessions is mandatory for cohort members. Sessions and topics for each session are aligned with the book Learning by Doing. Cohort Leaders will assign a written, job-embedded follow-up activity for each session. The Learning Community schedule is as follows:

Session 1 – Vision: A Clear and Compelling Purpose

Session 2 – Learning Accountability and Assessment: Focus on Learning

Session 3 – Instructional Leadership: Focus on Learning

Session 4 – Ethical Leadership: Responding When Students Don't Learn

Session 5 – Managing the Learning Environment: Building a Collaborative Culture

Session 6 – Decision Making: Creating a Results Oriented Culture

Session 7 – Human Resource Development: Using Relevant Information to Improve Results
